### Montclair is located in one of the most impacted air quality regions in Southern California

Why? → Mountains surrounding the basin restrict air movement, trapping air pollutants in the basin

### What type of pollutants? → Ozone, Nitrogen Dioxide, Particulate Matter


Sources? → Fuel combustion associated with motor vehicles, rail transit, & any industrial activities




## Montclair receives water from the Monte Vista Water District








### OVERWEIGHT/OBESITY UNDER AGE 17


