Montclair is located in one of the most impacted air quality regions in Southern California

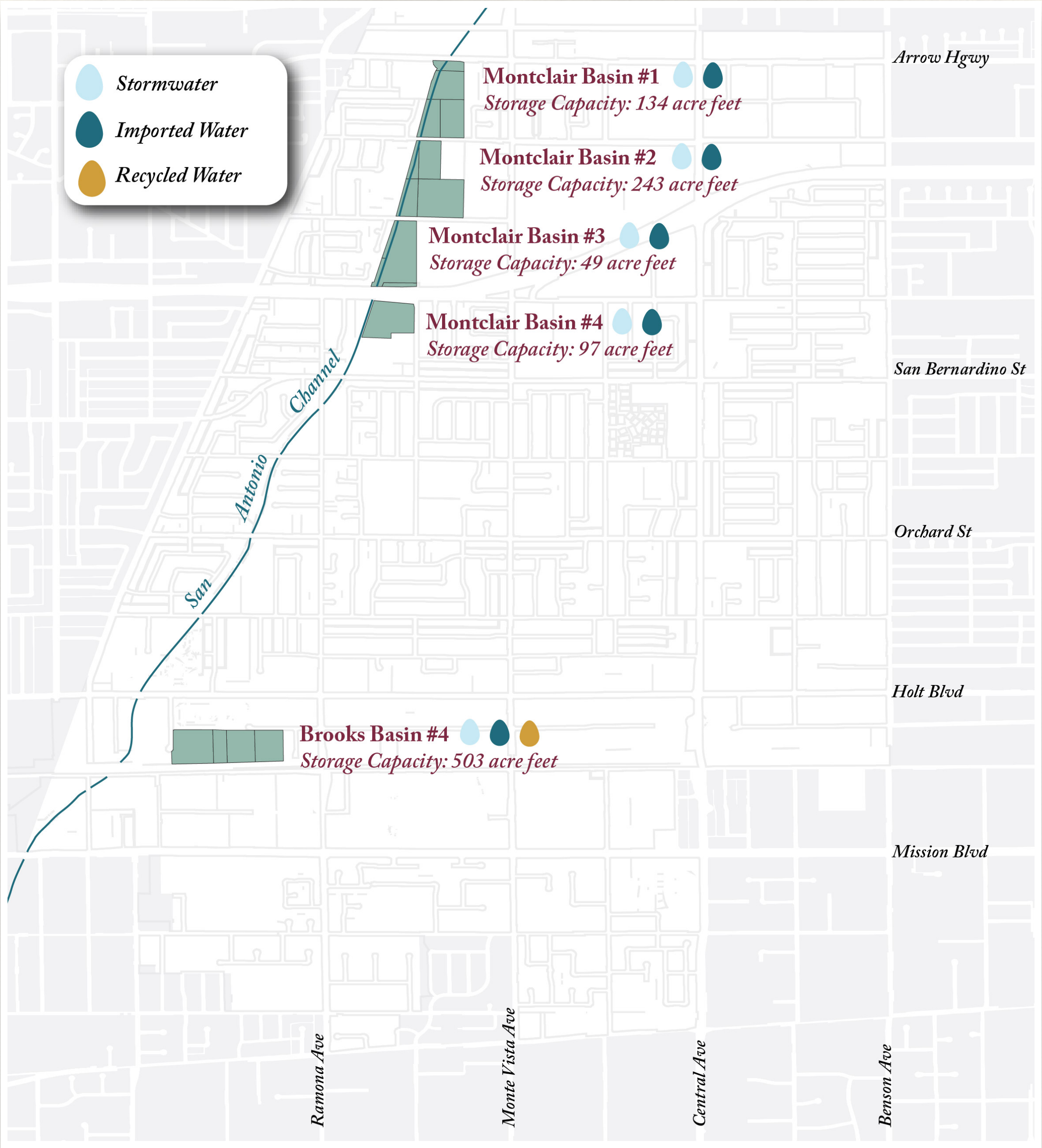
Why? → Mountains surrounding the basin restrict air movement, trapping air pollutants in the basin

What type of pollutants? → Ozone, Nitrogen Dioxide, Particulate Matter

Sources? → Fuel combustion associated with motor vehicles, rail transit, & any industrial activities

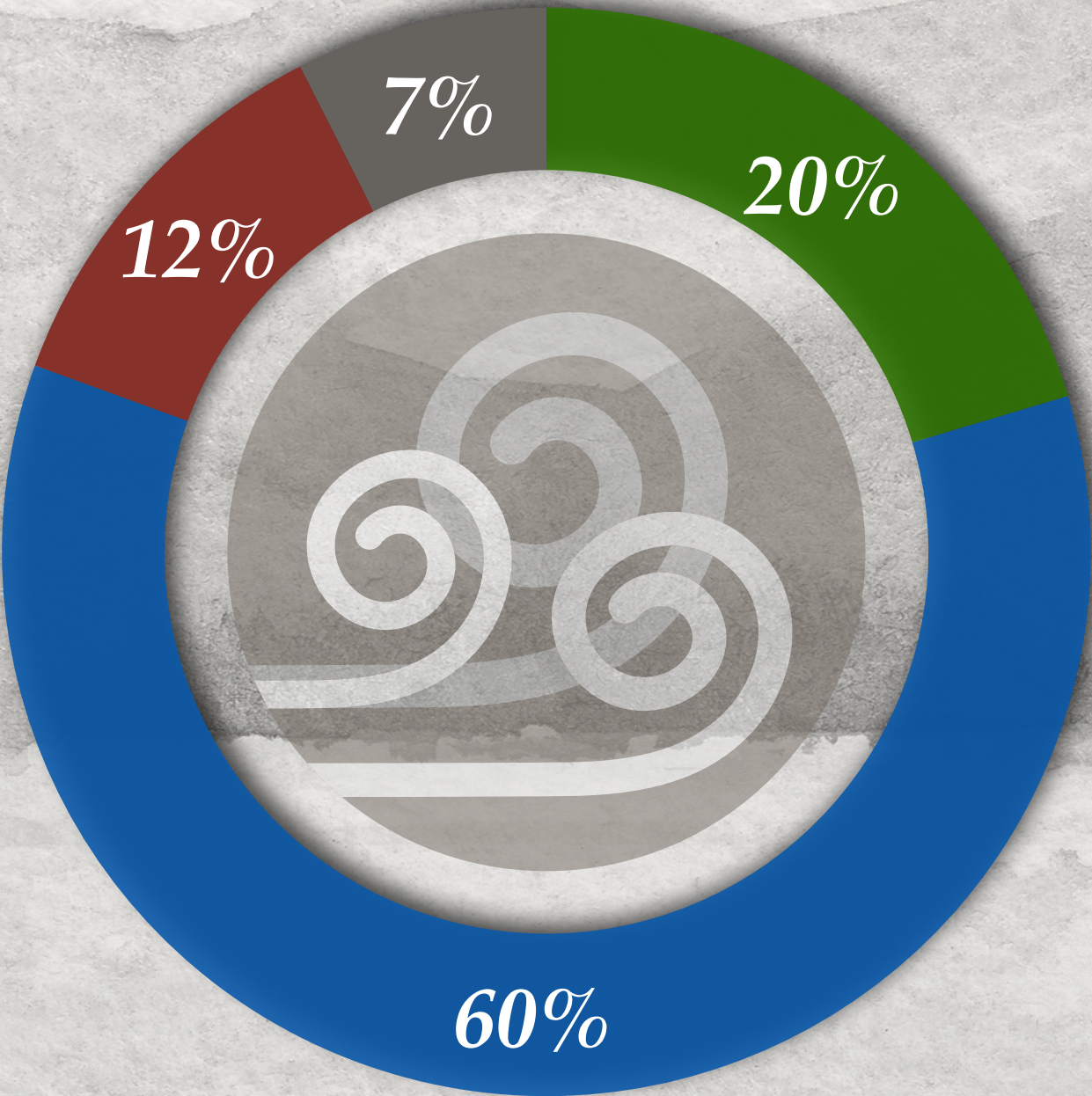

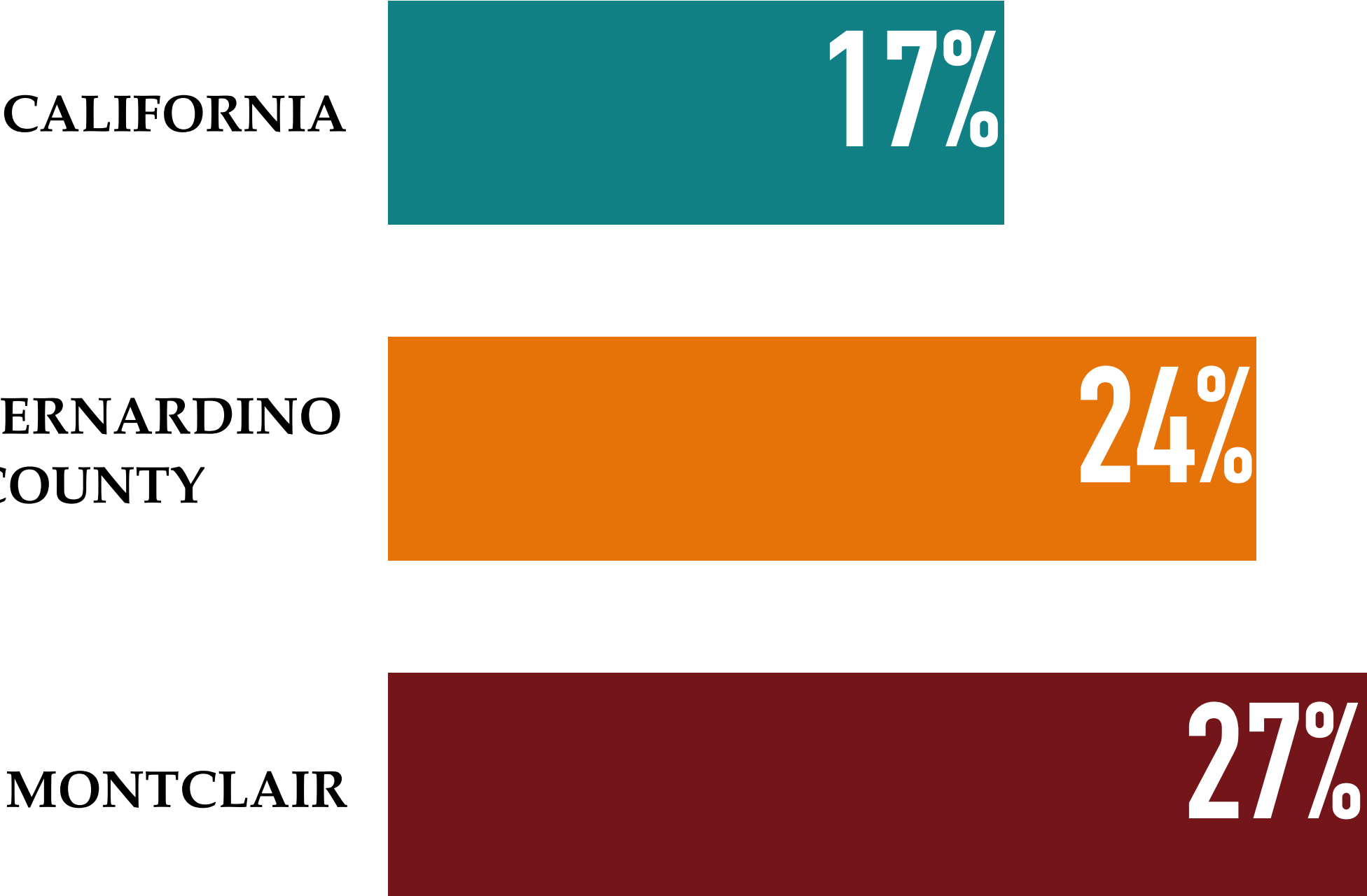


OVERWEIGHT/OBESITY UNDER AGE 17

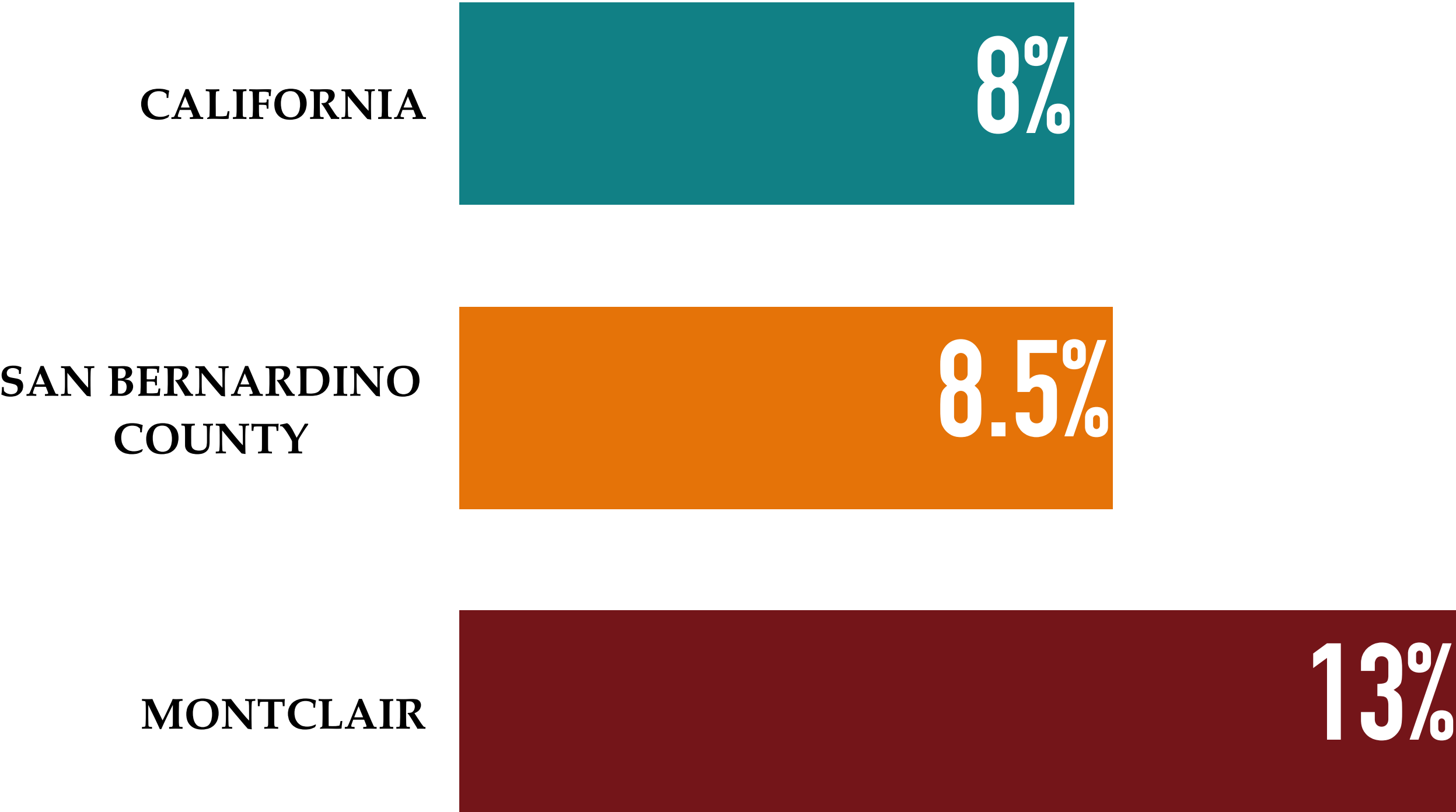

OR MORE TIMES PER DAY**

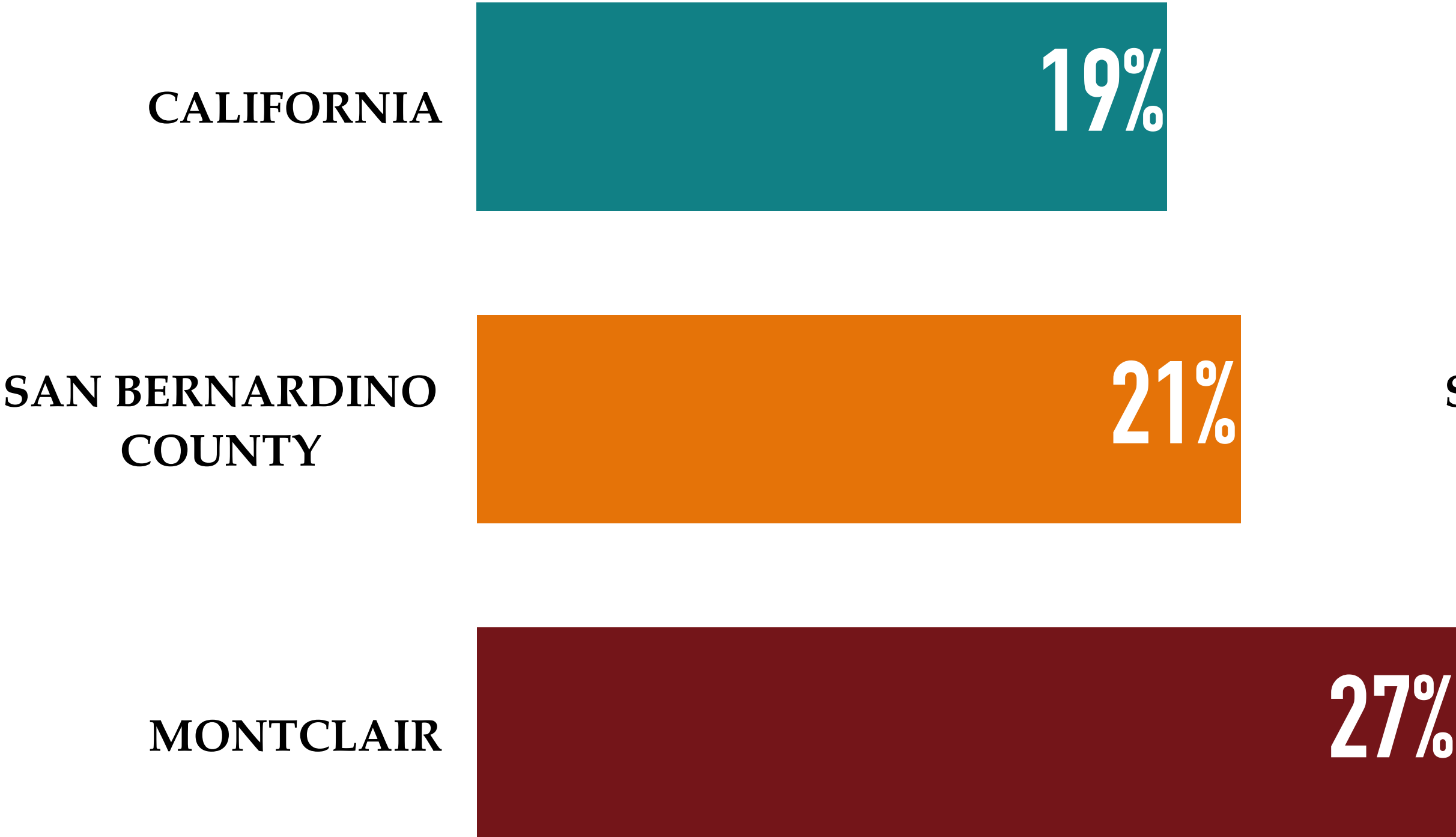

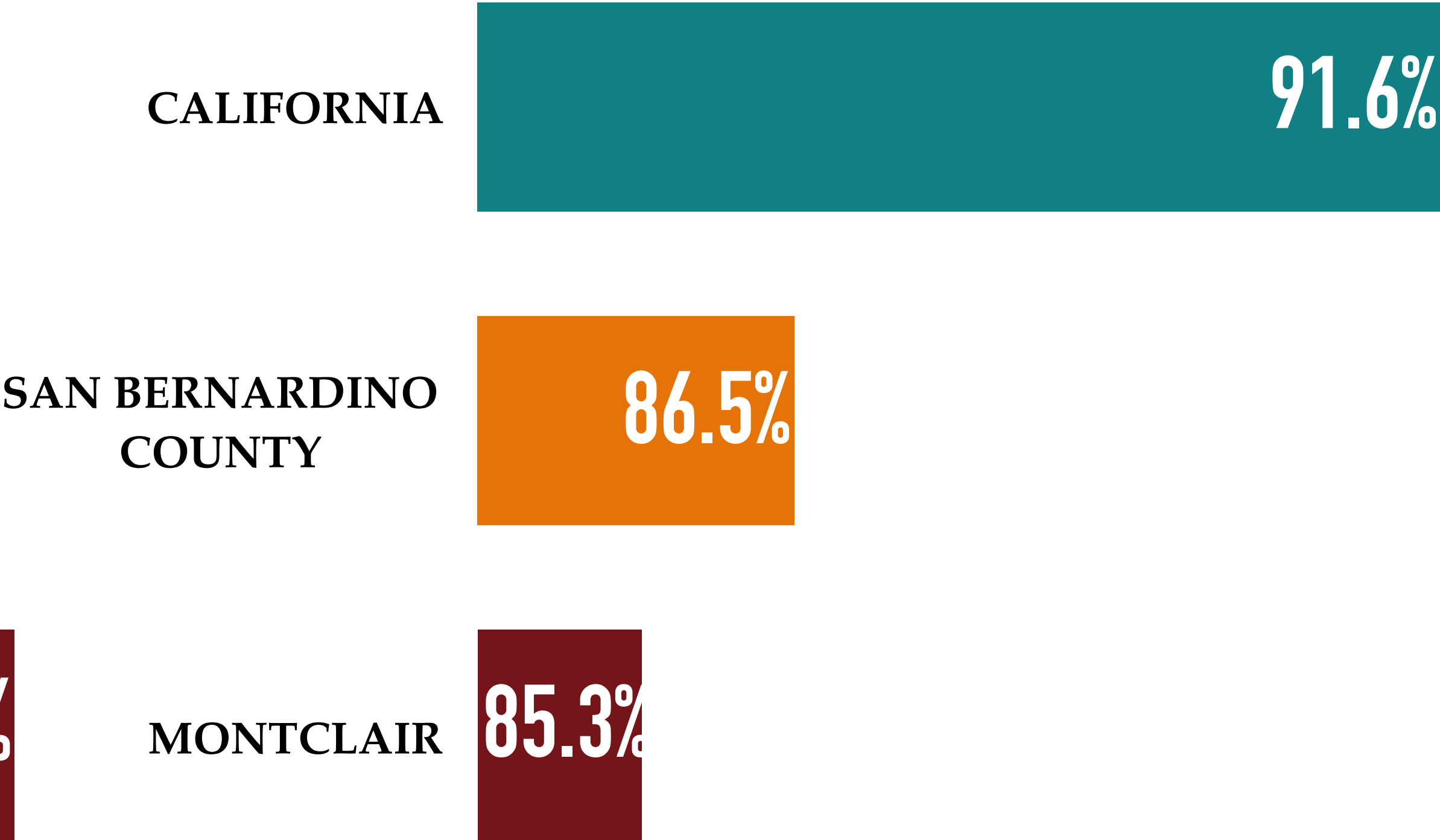

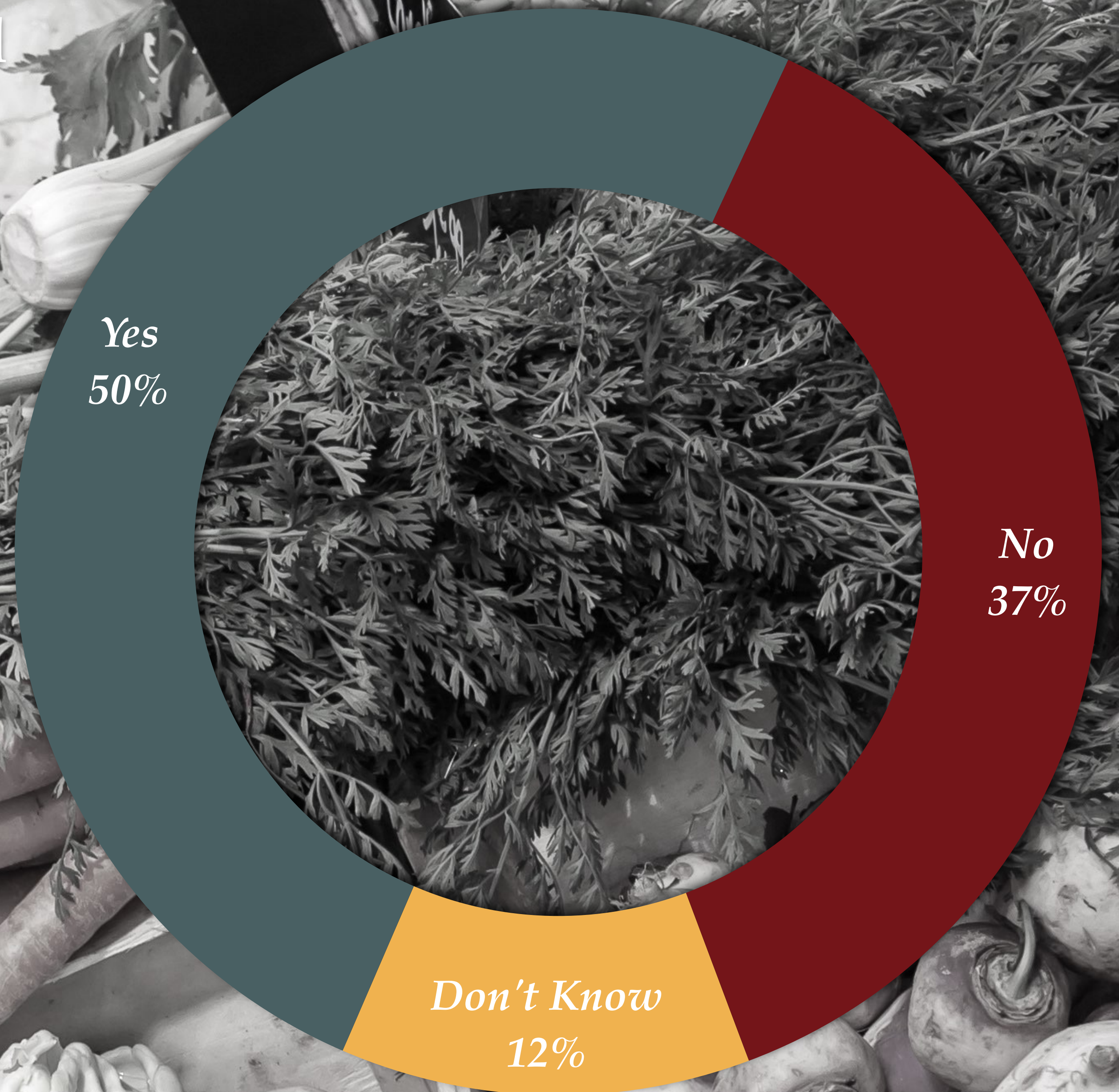
**VISITED DENTIST IN THE

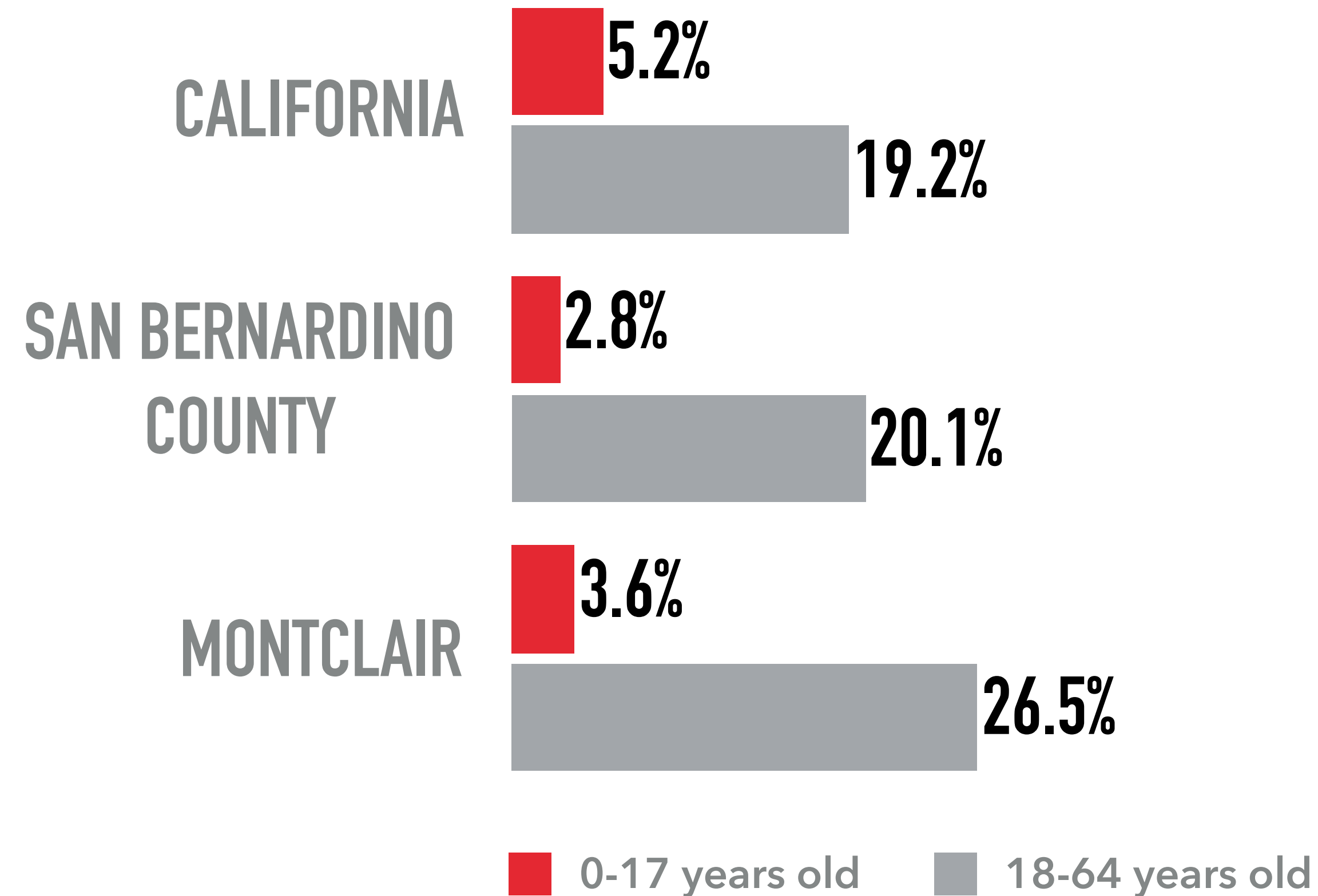

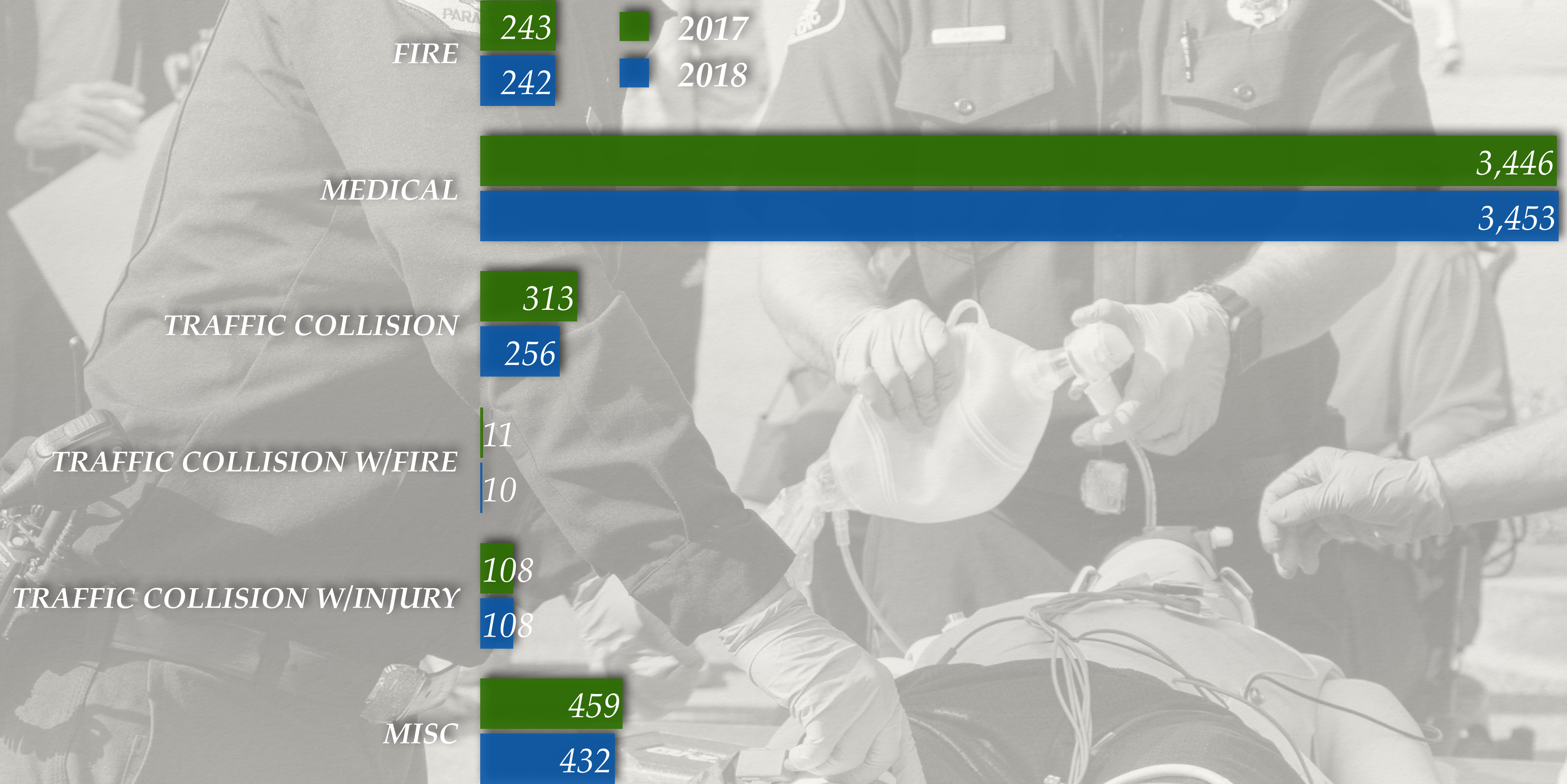
