




#### OVERWEIGHT/OBESITY UNDER AGE 17

## **SUGARY DRINK CONSUMPTION 1 OR MORE TIMES PER DAY**







- Areas with graffiti •

- Inadequate lighting at crosswalks •
- Parking on street makes certain people feel • unsafe
- Interacting with erratic drug-addicts and some • homeless people
- Feel unsafe at certain locations such as • check cashing, liquor store, pawnshop, 99
- cents store •
- Perception of gang presence •
- Perception of drug and theft activities •
- Need more police patrolling and presence • around schools
